The North - South Corridor

This segment of the BRI brings other China BRIs inter modal arteries to join the southbound Chongqing to Singapore route. This connectivity is of significance as it's the only multi-modal cross border transportation route that brings inland China closer to the fast growing economies of ASEAN. This approach enables cargo transit to be reduce from 18 days to 7 days. The southbound corridor also allows many Dextrans owned location offices into a closer cooperation.
